## APPENDIX 1.

### Serial Publications Devoted to Sirenia

*Dugong Newsletter*. One number only; 1979. 9 pp.

Created as a result of a workshop on dugong conservation held at James Cook University, Townsville, Australia, in May 1979. Edited by Helene Marsh, this newsletter was intended to appear two or three times a year, but was not continued.

*Florida Conservation News*.

Formerly published by the Florida Department of Natural Resources, Tallahassee. Two issues are largely devoted to sirenians:

Vol. 15, No. 2 (Nov. 1979): Contains the articles listed in this bibliography as Oberheu & Prather, 1979; Willis, C., 1979; Asper, E.D., 1979; and Anon., 1979b; together with proclamations of "Manatee Awareness Month" (November) by Elton J. Gissendanner (p. 2) and Governor Bob Graham (p. 20), and several unsigned short notices relating to manatee conservation in Florida.

Vol. 15, No. 6 (Mar. 1980): Contains the articles listed in this bibliography as Odell & Reynolds, 1980; Prather, R., 1980; Sunseri, S.M., 1980a, 1980b; Baker, G.S., 1980; Stewart, V.N., 1980; and Hoenstine, R., 1980; together with reproductions of children's letters about manatees (p. 20).

*JU Waterlines*.

A single-page leaflet published monthly starting in 1995 [?] by Jacksonville University with funding from the City of Jacksonville, Florida; edited by Dr. Quinton White. Issues are numbered by Volume and Number (12 issues/vol.), but bear no dates of publication; these, however, can be inferred from the dates of manatee sightings and temperature readings given. Some issue numbers are erroneous. Issues contain summaries of local manatee sightings and other news and announcements pertaining to manatees. The last known issue was Vol. X, No. X in November 2004, which announced that the publication was "becoming a web based newsletter."

*Manatee Monitor.*

Published by the Florida Department of Natural Resources Office of Education and Information, Tallahassee. Three known issues (April 1979, Fall 1979, Autumn 1980), each consisting of a four-page leaflet.

*Manatee News Quarterly.*

Published by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Tallahassee (later the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission); edited chiefly by Bonnie J. Abellera. Its forerunners were collections of Department of Natural Resources "Monthly Progress Reports" covering dates through March 1989; starting with April 1989 these bore the subject line "Monthly Update". Beginning with the March 27, 1990 issue (the first in a new summary format), this was changed to "Update", and these reports were entitled "Update" or "Monthly Update" thereafter. Starting April 29, 1993 with the issue for March 1993, the title was "*MTAC Update*", and a newsletter-like layout was introduced starting with the Oct.-Dec. 1994 issue. These were all internal documents mainly for the use of members of the Department's Manatee Technical Advisory Council. Prior to Fall 1994, these updates were sent to Council members in the form of memoranda. The title *Manatee News Quarterly*, and a broader distribution, were introduced in 1997. Listing of Council members was omitted from the masthead beginning with issue 7(1), when the FWCC suspended the Council's activities. *Manati. Zeitschrift des Vereins der Tiergartenfreunde Nürnberg e. V. und des Tiergartens der Stadt Nürnberg.*

Published by the Nuremberg Zoological Garden, Germany. Continues and supersedes the zoo's earlier series entitled *Tiergarten Aktuell*, which published 10 volumes from 1985 to 1995; *Manati* accordingly began in June 1996 with volume 11, number 1. Though not devoted exclusively to sirenians, it frequently contains articles on them, which are listed in this bibliography by their authors.

*Mote News.*

Published by Mote Marine Laboratory, Sarasota, Florida. Vol. 41, No. 3 (Fall 1996) is largely devoted to manatees, and contains the articles listed in this bibliography as Anonymous, 1996b, 1996c; Arnold, D.W., 1996; Koelsch, J.K., 1996; and Russell, B.J., 1996; together with a notice on p. 4 of a bequest to support captive manatee care.

*Peixe-Boi.*

Published by the Centro Nacional de Conservação e Manejo de Sirênios - Centro Peixe-Boi/IBAMA, João Pessoa, Paraíba, Brazil. Edited by Danielle Paludo. ISSN no. 0103-9431. A single known issue:

*Save the Manatee Club News/The Manatee Zone.*

Published several times a year by the Save the Manatee Club, Maitland, Florida, initially under the auspices of the Florida Department of Natural Resources and the Florida Audubon Society. Most early issues are not numbered; some are not dated. Beginning with the July 1988 issue, the title was changed to *Save the Manatee: Save the Manatee Club Newsletter*. This became simply *Save the Manatee Club Newsletter* in February 1993, and *The Manatee Zone* in November 1999. The June 1983 issue was accompanied by a one-page "*Manatee Technical Bulletin* No. 1" that reported the death of a manatee from a boat collision; apparently no more of this series were published.
